### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EU STUDENTS ONLY:**

You must apply for your EU certificate online at the Danish Agency for International Recruitment and Integration (SIRI) in advance. Please follow the guidelines on our webpage "EU Students" <https://www.newstudents.aau.dk/masters-cph/information/residence-cpr/>

We strongly advise you to book a meeting with SIRI on their special opening days for EU students where your EU registration certificate **is issued on the same day (while you wait)**. SIRI's booking system opens in July. Make sure to book your meeting well in advance as available spots will fill up fast:

Special opening hours SIRI 2022:

- Tuesday 23 August 2022 in between 08:30 - 16:00
- Friday 26 August 2022 in between 12:00 - 17:00
- Saturday 27 August 2022 in between 09:00 - 16:00
- Tuesday 13 September 2022 in between 08:30 - 16:00
- Saturday 17 September 2022 in between 09:00 - 16:00

Please note: You will need the EU certificate for your CPR and if you do not book and arrange your application in time, you may have to wait three to four weeks to get the certificate.
