there will be a new kind of survey from this semester, where it hopefully would be easier for the students to evaluate the courses.

7. Master intake numbers 2023

We looked at the intake numbers, nothing surprising this year.

 $18~1^{\rm st}$ priorities for MSc in Medialogy (AAL) are good, as there are only 15 students at MED6 this semester in Aalborg.

8. Semester group meeting minutes, Spring 2023

There were no actions for the Study Board in the semester group meeting (SMG) minutes.

However, NCN told that one of the teachers at MED2 (CPH) is on a sick leave, and he foresee that it will reflect on the quality of the semester, and we will see that in future SMG minutes from MED2 (CPH).

CUR added that there have been problems with students not having automatically access to Moodle rooms for the SMC8/MED8 merge courses. It used to work, but after the merge there has been problems. SMC8 and MED8 (CPH) are also struggling with two teachers and a study secretary on sick leaves. Therefore, it is hard to figure out who does what, who to contact with problems/changes etc. On top of that, the group room, which now are used for lectures, were not ready to handle lectures. There were missing TV, plugs etc.

NCN and CUR do not find that the merged streamed courses across campuses works. NCN prefer taking the train back and forth to AAL to teach in stead of stream it to AAL.

LGR added that there also are problems with the *Theory and Practice of Game Design and Development* course that are shared online with AAL. The teacher, Carlos Mauricio Castaño Díaz, will make some changes to try to make it better.

Action: CBM will contact the Head of studies and the Head of section in both AAL and CPH to inform them about the issues with the shared streamed courses across campuses.

We had an open debate regarding ChatGPT. Topics like cheating, copyright, etic, references and tool for teaching/exam were discussed.
