

## Overview of censorship on project module examinations at the BSc and MSC in Techno-Anthropology

The BSc and MSc in Techno-Anthropology are interdisciplinary study programmes that revolve around themes like technology, anthropology and ethics.

In order to favor both the technological and the anthropological aspects of the study programme, two different corps of external examiners are used for the product module examinations; the external examiners corps on Nationwide engineering examiners/Mathematics, Physics and Social Studies (Basic Courses) and the Danish National Anthropological Examiner Corps.

Below is an overview of which of the two corps of external examiners that is used on each of the semesters at the study programmes.

## **BSc in Techno-Anthropology**

1. semester: internal censorship

2. semester: internal censorship

3. semester: external censorship - the Danish National Anthropological Examiner Corps

4. semester: external censorship - the external examiners corps on Nationwide engineering examiners

5. semester: semester: external censorship - the Danish National Anthropological Examiner Corps

6. semester: external censorship - the student must choose between the external examiners corps on Nationwide engineering examiners or the Danish National Anthropological Examiner Corps

## **MSc in Techno-Anthropology**

7. semester: internal censorship

8. semester: external censorship - the external examiners corps on Nationwide engineering examiners

9. semester: internal censorship

10. semester: external censorship – the student must choose between the external examiners corps on Nationwide engineering examiners or the Danish National Anthropological Examiner Corps
