## The public conclusions and recommendations of the semester coordinator

The biggest issue to tackle is how to increase the response rate of the students in the survey. A more active participation in the survey would provide more data to the semester coordinator, the teachers and the Study Board. This is an item that surely requires further attention. In addition, it is important to try to more closely monitor how the semester is proceeding – for example, by getting more regularly in touch with students. For the "Strategy and business in services" course, more granular information on the final assignments should be provided.

Some attention should also be put in improving the physical study environment (possibly with additional rooms for students and better overall lighting conditions).
