#### The public conclusions and recommendations of the semester coordinator

The semester went really well, as evident from semester group meeting minutes with only very minor issues that were readily resolved by either coordinator or secretary. In bullet-form, the main observations for the semester are:

- Influx of guest students caused ripples in the group forming something to be aware of for next instalment of the semester ... coordinator will need to scaffold
- Student survey response rate was 7/28 which is disappointingly low hopefully the new timing for surveys (June for spring semesters) will improve this
- The number of mini projects, and their perceived extent, continue to stress students throughout the semester. Coordinator will need to discuss this with course teachers for next installment.
- Student self-reported preparation for lectures is low ties in o overall action of trying to get students to invest more in study workload


#### Conclusion of the study board
