#### The public conclusions and recommendations of the semester coordinator

The responses to the questionnaire about the semester are primarily positive but the answers are too few. An effort will be done to engage more students in answering the evaluation. This should start already at the 7th semester, so the students get the habit of answering these questionnaires after each semester.

Perhaps the students get confused because the courses, innovation project and POSEO are mixed in the questionnaire. E.g. I don't understand why the students give answers about a course none of the students participated in (the SSD course), I think they get confused. And I don't understand why a course which is not conducted by the Lighting Design team is in the evaluation report.

One area where a student disagreed was about the supervision and this issue we need to discuss in the group of teachers. In the LiD9 semester 2023 we had one student who had to change from internship to innovation project due to collaboration difficulties, this could also have caused the negative answers. The situation was chaotic for the students and the supervisor and I, as the coordinator, helped the student on track again with an innovation project and we do not recommend students to do an internship in that company again.


The Study Board (MSN) has processed the semester evaluation report and offers the following observations/conclusions:


When I reflect on my own efforts, I have: - Participated actively in the project group work






I experience the problem-based and project-oriented form of teaching as conducive to the development of: - My ability to identify and formulate problems




I experience the problem-based and project-oriented form of teaching as conducive to the development of: - My ability to attack and process problems




