This document represents the public version of the evaluation of the semester. The document forms together with the semester and teaching evaluation report the basis of any adjustments to the semester's description, planning, execution and/or evaluation of the next iteration of the semester and are used by the coming semester coordinator and semester planning group.

The document also represents the study board's response to the students, teachers, coordinators and other interested parties about possible consequences of conditions that the students of the semester have pointed out.

The public conclusions and recommendations of the semester coordinator

In general, the semester worked well, and all students managed to get their plans fulfilled and were generally satisfied in the 3 modalities that were implemented namely: POSEO in companies, POSEO in CREATE labs, and DADIU. These was the first edition with the new study program in which there were no courses programmed for Med 9.

Several detailed information meetings were held, and information posted online during the previous semester, and this resulted in many students having approved plans before semester start. We and the students are getting used to the new digital platform for POSEO approval, so the workflow was more fluid than last year. However, there are still some impractical functionalities of the system that make hard to maintain an overview of the approval process.

As last year, POSEO remains the preferred option (17 students), followed by DADIU (7 students) and POSEO in CREATE labs (3 students). POSEO in CREATE labs keeps being a very productive and satisfying experience both for the students and the staff involved.

Our new employability ambassador arrived in too short notice to be able to include career development elements during the semester as we had successfully implemented in the previous years (e.g., workshops, mid-terms). But with our new Employability Ambassador and the new career development staff at AAU-Sydhavn, we are intensively rebuilding these activities again.


Conclusion of the study board

The Study Board (MSN) has processed the semester evaluation report and offers the following observations/conclusions:


- 4 out of 28 respondents. Much too low.



- My professional skills




I experience the problem-based and project-oriented form of teaching as conducive to the development of: - My ability to identify and formulate problems


