

## Study board conclusions of the study programme evaluation report

This document represents the public version of the evaluation of the abovementioned programme and year and is based on responses from students (at the end of the last semester of the programme) to a questionnaire about their experiences with the contents of the programme, coherence, progression and study load, etc.

The conclusions from the study board (below) represents the board's decision about the adjustments that should be made based on the evaluation of the students. The conclusion can include information from semester and teaching evaluations, earlier study programme evaluations and other information from students, teachers, employer panel, etc. known by the study board.

The document also represents the study board's response to graduates, students, teachers and other interested parties about the conclusions made based on the responses of the graduates.

## Summary of the graduate responses

The evaluation questionnaire is answered by 2 students. They are happy with their education and say that the academic level of the program is high and very high. The education leaves up to their expectation to a high degree. The students indicated that they were studying approx. 46 hours per week.

Even though this data is collected just from two students, the head of the study board believes that it is representative for the whole education. The data confirms the feedback that have been received from the students via semester group meetings and via direct conversations.

## Study board conclusions

Based on the data available, the study board concludes that no changes should be done in the curriculum. The students are highly satisfied with the education and with its high academic level. The students indicated that they were studying approx. 46 hours per week.
